Pathways to university

Southbank Institute of Technology has partnered with major Queensland universities to give diploma, advanced diploma and associate degree graduates recognition for the quality of education and training they receive at Southbank Institute. Students can:

- enter into a university degree course after completing a diploma without reapplying through the Queensland Tertiary Admissions Centre (QTAC). This is called a dual award.

- enrol in a triple award course that allows you to study concurrently at Southbank Institute and at a university
- acquire multiple qualifications at diploma and degree levels. Through recognition of prior learning, this linking, or articulation, creates a seamless pathway to higher qualifications.

Didn't get the OP you wanted?

Not getting the right Overall Position (OP score) isn't the end of university study. Completing any Southbank Institute of Technology diploma, advanced diploma or Certificate IV in Adult Tertiary Preparation may improve your OP score, heightening your chances of securing a place to university.

Southbank Institute of Technology is a recognised centre of excellence for its pathways to universities. Most Southbank Institute diplomas and advanced diplomas articulate into degree courses with our partner universities. In many cases these articulation arrangements are dual awards.

So what's a dual award?

At Southbank Institute of Technology, choose from over 50 diploma/degree combined courses - you complete the diploma at Southbank Institute then go to university to take up a place that has already been reserved for you. You don't have to reapply through QTAC. In most cases you get at least a year's academic credit towards your degree.

Credit transfer arrangement

A university will grant credit towards a degree for the successful completion of a related diploma (e.g. Diploma of Information Technology going to a Bachelor of Information Technology). The credit is pre-determined or pre-negotiated on your behalf but entry into the degree is not guaranteed. You still have to apply through the Queensland Tertiary Admissions Centre or QTAC to gain entry into the degree, but once admitted to the degree you will be given the pre-determined credit on application. Often this credit is as much as one year of the degree**.

Performance Level Assessment (PLA)***

Many Southbank Institute diplomas and advanced diplomas have subjects (also called competencies) that have PLA as a supplementary reporting system.

PLA is an additional way of rating certain aspects of student achievement. If as a student you demonstrate an advanced level of performance, you will be awarded a Credit, and a Distinction is awarded for exceptional level of performance.

PLA has a number of advantages:

- QTAC uses PLA results to improve a student's Tertiary Entrance Ranking (OP equivalent)
- If you are disappointed with your high school results, you have an opportunity to enhance your OP through PLA when studying a diploma or advanced diploma. You may be able to get a rank that is as good as OP 6 equivalent thereby opening up a wider range of university courses that were not initially available to you when you left school.
- Evidence of additional effort and performance can also enhance your employment prospects.

Articulation

The chart below demonstrates how articulation works



* As at 21 December 2008. QUT and Griffith University give bonus ranking of up to five points for a Diploma completed at Southbank Institute. This is competency based training and assumes competency will be achieved in every course (subject).

** The exact amount of credit varies depending on the specific details of each credit transfer arrangement.

*** Please note, not all qualifications offered at Southbank Institute have competencies with PLA attached. Generally it is not the whole qualification with PLA but rather some competencies within it.

- 1 Dual or Triple Award- entry into university is guaranteed, based on the successful completion of all subjects specified in the credit arrangement between Southbank Institute of Technology and the respective universities.
- 2 These courses require students to reapply through QTAC for University entry.
- 3 In semester four of the course, students complete some subjects at Griffith University while studying at Southbank Institute of Technology.
- 4 Graduates of this Diploma should apply directly to Charles Sturt University.
- 5 Up to 5 students who meet certain requirements at the end of year 1 of the diploma or advanced diploma are eligible to commence concurrent study at Southbank Institute of Technology and Griffith University in year 2. Students will obtain the diploma at the end of year 2 and the degree at the end of year 3.
- 6 It is recommended that participants have 5 years work experience as well as practical human resources, management, marketing or project management experience and an understanding of issues in large organisations.
- 7 This pathway only applies to the July intake at SBIT.
- 8 Application for admission into the MTD must be made directly to Griffith University; credit of 20 credit points will be granted for the Graduate Certificate in Training and Development (Adult Literacy and Numeracy specialisation) which is the first half of the Masters Program.
- 9 Application for admission into the MDD must be made directly to Griffith University; credit of up to 25% of the course may be granted, subject to discussion with the MDD convenor.
- 10 Entry into the university course is via QTAC application and a successful audition at QUT.
- 11 Application for admission in the M Ed must be made directly to QUT. Upon entry, credit of 24 credit points (or two units) will be granted and the requirement of one year's teaching experience waived.
- 12 Application for admission into the MTD must be made directly to Griffith University. 10 credit points will be granted to the Graduate Certificate and a further 10 credit points will be granted on students' progression into the MTD.
- 13 Application for admission into the MEd must be made directly to QUT. Upon admission 10 credit points will be awarded towards the Masters.
- 14 Application for admission into the MPRM must be made directly to USQ. Upon admission 10 credit points will be awarded towards the Masters.

* This is the amount of time remaining at university after credit for Southbank Institute studies has been deducted from the usual degree duration.

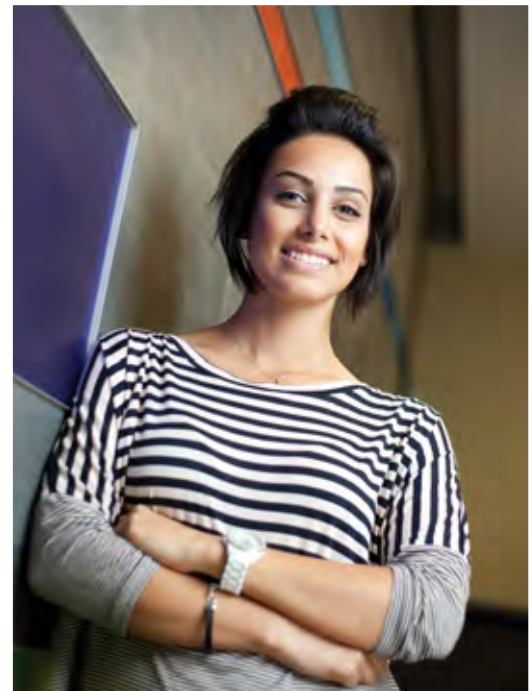

VET FEE-HELP assists eligible students undertaking certain Vocational Education and Training (VET) courses at Southbank Institute to pay for all or part of their tuition costs (excludes incidental fees). VET FEE-HELP is an Australian Government initiative and is an extension of FEE-HELP, as part of the Higher Education Loan Program (HELP). Students repay the loan to the Australian Government through the tax system once a student reaches the minimum income threshold level for repayment.
